This award will be made to the financial aid office of the school the student will be attending to offset his/her/their educational costs.

Who is Eligible: Any high school senior attending school in Connecticut Regional District 20 or Forman School.

Application deadlines: Submit your application with associated attachments by April 11th, 2025. All applicants will be notified of the selected award winner by June 1st. Applications must be submitted by (either or both):

2. **Resume:** Employment experiences; volunteer and community service; school leadership/extracurricular activities; other relevant accomplishments
3. **Current High School Transcript:** including GPA and class ranking if available
4. **SAR (Student Aid Report) from FAFSA** – include pages with
 - a. Overall annual school costs (estimated)
 - b. EFC score (expected family contribution)
 - c. If FAFSA is not available at the time of your application, please list your overall expected annual school costs and expected family contribution
5. **Other Aid:** Please list any other scholarships or financial aid/assistance you will be utilizing to attend college/university/post-secondary program.
6. **Recommendations:** Please submit two (2) letters of recommendation relevant to this application. This can be from any important or influential adult but not a family member.
7. **Essay:** In 500 to 800 words, please share the story of why you are applying for the Friends of Topsmead State Forest Scholarship.
